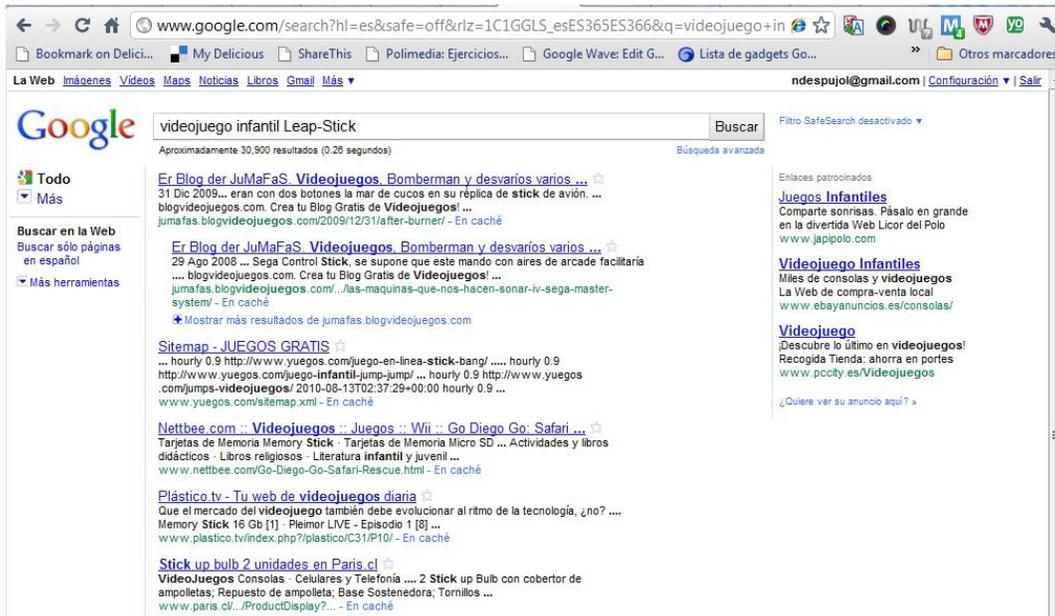


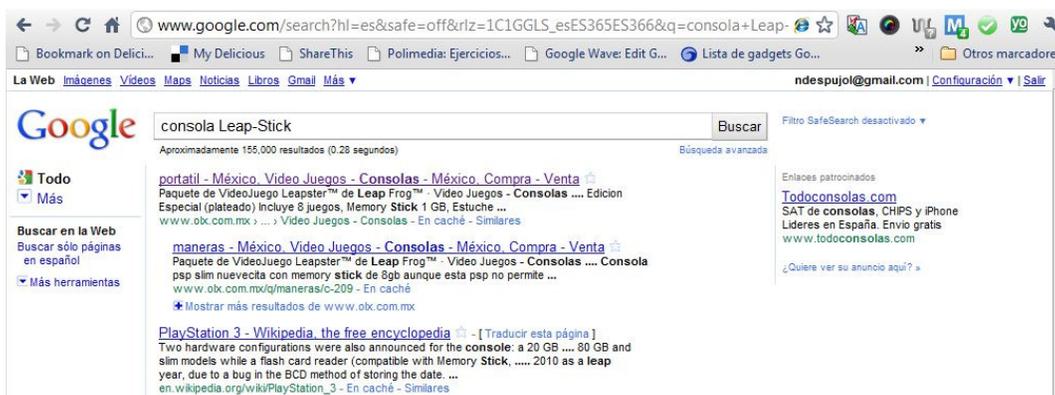
## Ejemplo 1: Búsqueda de consola infantil

Comentaremos un ejemplo de búsqueda refinando la búsqueda. Se trataba de buscar una consola de video juegos infantiles cuyo nombre alguien recordaba más o menos como “Leap-Stick”. Realizamos primero una búsqueda infructuosa con “videojuego infantil Leap-Stick”.
